

Step Up For Diabetes 2022 Terms and Conditions

- By registering for the Step Up For Diabetes 2022 challenge (the "Challenge"), participants ("Participants") agree to the collection, use, and disclosure of the Participant's personal information by National Healthcare Group Fund and/or the James Dyson Foundation (jointly, the "Organisers").
- Participants consent to the collection, use and disclosure of their Personal Data (as defined in the Personal Data Protection Act 2012) for the purposes of the Challenge, including but not limited to administration, advertising, promotional, educational, and/or marketing purposes.
- Furthermore, by registering for the Challenge, each Participant is deemed to have accepted and agreed to abide by these T&Cs, the terms of NHG's Data Protection Notification (https://corp.nhg.com.sg/Pages/PDPA.aspx), NHG's Personal Data Protection Policy, and any amendments, additions replacements made thereto from time to time, which shall be final and binding in all respects on each Participant.
- The Participant must provide true, accurate, current and complete information about the Participant in the online registration form. If a Participant provides any information that is untrue, inaccurate, not current or incomplete, the Participant's registration may be rejected without reason and without notice.
- Registration is only confirmed after the proof of receipt is verified and a confirmation email is sent.
- To clock-in for the Step Up For Diabetes 2022 Virtual Run & Walk, participants must use the Strava app for the completed distance to be registered. The Strava app is a third-party mobile application, and use of the Strava app is at the Participant's own discretion and risk. To the extent permissible by law, the Organisers will not be responsible for any injury, loss, damage, death or accidents

experienced as a result of or in connection with the Participant's downloading, installation, or use of the Strava app.

- The virtual run & walk must be completed within the challenge period of 24 October 2022 to 30 October 2022. Any distance covered after the end date will not be considered.
- After completion, the Participant's race entitlement will be arranged within 30 days. We will contact the Participants to arrange for collection.
- Participants participate in the virtual run & walk entirely at their own risk and are 100% responsible for selecting a safe route to run. To the extent permissible by law, the Organisers will not be responsible for any injury, loss, damage, death or accidents experienced as a result of participation in the Challenge.
- Participants agree to waive, release and forever discharge the Organisers of the Challenge and agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Organisers (including their officers, directors, servants, employees, agents and volunteers) against any and all claims for losses, expenses, claims, demands, costs, damages, injuries or death or any liability arising in any way arising from their participation in the Challenge or any related activity
- Participants accept and consent to the Organisers' use and/or publication of any photograph, video, film, audio recording that may contain the Participant's image, voice, or statement taken or made in relation to the Challenge, including but not limited to any images/videos where the Participants are tagged on social media/ channels and/or submitted on the Strava app, for purposes linked to the Challenge. The Organisers shall not be required to notify the Participants of such use or make any payments for such use.
- Organisers reserve the right to modify and/ or substitute any of these rules and regulations without prior notice. Participants should check the official Challenge webpages/web links for the latest T&Cs.
- The Organisers' decision on all matters arising out of or in connection with the Challenge shall be final and binding on the Participants.
